#### **Mobile Phones in School**

We would be grateful if you would remind pupils that if they carry a phone to school they must switch it off when they arrive in the building and they should not be used for texting or phone calls during the school day. Phones must be handed to the PE at the start of the lesson to be locked in the valuable box staff during the lesson. It is school policy that pupil are not allowed to take photographs with their phones etc.
