

Well done to the 4 pupils who made it through to the final shortlist of entries from this nationwide competition. They are: Matthew Douglas, Dean Carmichael, Owen Meehan and Kyle Devlin.

At the end of April we had Judges into the department to view the work of 9 senior pupils. Their National 5 Design work and final pieces were being judged as part of The Trades House of Glasgow Schools Craft Competition. They were very impressed by the work they saw. We have had a letter inviting all of the pupils involved to the Prize Giving on Thursday, 8th June. Fingers crossed!!!

At the end of last term Jai Drake attended the Awards Ceremony in Edinburgh of the Friends of the RSA Schools Art Award 2017. He won First Prize in one category, winning an amazing £250 for himself! He also had his winning entry on show in the Royal Scottish Academy in Edinburgh for

two weeks. Pupils from S2-S6 had the opportunity to enter this competition, and we had send in a large number of great entries. We have had the artwork returned and a variety of pieces are on display, along with Jai's winning entry, in the school hall.
